Philippines' Nationally Determined Contribution

Commitment1:

A projected GHG emissions reduction and avoidance of **75%**, of which 2.71% is unconditional and 72.29% is conditional, representing the country's ambition for GHG mitigation for the period 2020 to 2030 for the sectors of **agriculture**, **wastes**, **industry**, **transport**, **and energy**.



The Philippines' NDC Implementation Plan (NDCIP)

- ❖ identifies the priority PAMs in the agriculture, waste, industry, transport, and energy sectors
- provides a <u>conservative estimate of the investment</u> requirements to deliver the country's NDC targets amounting to <u>USD72 billion</u>



- Engaged <u>academic institutions</u>, <u>civil society</u>, <u>private sector</u>, and <u>local government units</u> in the preparation process.




