The Paris Committee on Capacity-building aims

*“... to address **gaps and needs**, both current and emerging, in implementing **capacity-building** in developing country Parties and further enhance capacity-building efforts, including with regard to **coherence and coordination** in capacity-building activities under the Convention.”*

(1/CP.21, paragraph 71)



At COP 25, the PCCB was reviewed and its mandate extended by five years (**Decision 9/CP.25**). In further refining the mandate of the PCCB, the COP set out three priority areas to ensure that the Paris Committee on Capacity-building can operate effectively and efficiently:



Enhancing coherence
and coordination



Identifying capacity gaps
and needs



Promoting awareness-
raising .

- Capacity-building work of bodies established under the Convention and its Kyoto Protocol.
