Background and mandate

* AC workplan:

- Event in 2020 with the PCCB on identifying gaps and solutions related to incorporating gender considerations into adaptation planning and implementation
- Call for submissions by Parties & observer orgs. on how to mainstream gender into the process to formulate and implement NAPs
 - > 22 submissions:
 - ➤ 6 Parties (EU, Mexico [EIG], Benin, Canda USA and Kenya)
 - > 16 non-Party stakeholders



Preliminary summary of submissions

- ❖ Part 1: Processes and approaches on how to mainstream gender into the process to formulate and implement NAPs
 - gender analysis using gender-disaggregated data,
 - capacity-building for gender mainstreaming,
 - supporting gender-responsive climate finance,
 - ensuring gender-responsive stakeholder engagement,
 - gender-responsive approaches to Disaster Risk Reduction, and
 - > aligning adaptation processes with national and global gender policies
- ❖ Part 2: Gaps related to incorporating gender considerations into adaptation planning and implementation
 - gaps in data and information,
 - need for capacity-building and financial support, and
 - gaps in addressing structural inequalities

- Bridging the gap between gender mainstreaming needs and international support: budgeting adaptation planning and implementation with gender in mind
- Promoting gender analysis in the NAP process: using sexdisaggregated data
- Reducing gender inequalities through NAPs by raising awareness and building capacity
