Overview and Approach

Overview of submissions:

24 Parties and Groups of Parties representing 180 Parties, and 44 non-Party stakeholders, totaling 787 pages (423 from Parties and 371 from NPS)

Methodology and Approach

- Report synthesizes the submissions along the indicative draft structure agreed at SB 58 and provides some narrative overviews
- Some Parties put forward recommendations on the structure; particularly under Section C.
- Reflects terminology as submitted by Parties and non-Party stakeholders.
- Some Parties submitted proposed actual decision text for consideration and others submitted a description of elements.



Structure

- The synthesis report reflects the following without prejudging or prejudicing what Parties may ultimately agree on:
 - (a) Backward looking: collective progress, gaps, challenges and barriers
 - (b) Forward looking: opportunities and messages for further progress
- Includes sub-headings, based on common elements made under most of the submissions: e.g. Equity considerations, Best available science, Finance flows, NCQG)
- Also reflects views on the nature of the GST outcome e.g. decision, political declaration and technical annex
- The report is meant to serve as a discussion tool for the workshop not a basis for negotiations
