Introduction and background

- ➤ CMA 2: Requests the AC to consider approaches to reviewing the overall progress made in achieving the global goal on adaptation and to reflect the outcome of this consideration in its 2021 annual report
- AC 2019-2021 workplan: Preparation of a technical paper on useful information and methodologies for assessing progress in enhancing adaptive capacity, strengthening resilience and reducing vulnerability to climate change
- ✓ This draft technical paper is intended to provide input to the AC's consideration of approaches



Overview of the draft technical paper

- 1. Review of scientific literature
- 2. Review of examples of national approaches from developed and developing countries to assessing adaptation progress, including scoreboards, desired adaptation outcomes, indicator-based frameworks, informal knowledge-exchange, questionnaires and information collection cards
- **3. Discussion of potential approaches** to reviewing progress towards the global goal on adaptation
 - Basic quantitative indicators (e.g. number of NAPs submitted, number of countries reporting on vulnerability assessments)
 - Using existing data and indicators from the SDGs, Sendai Framework, or other relevant international sources
 - Qualitative synthesis of Party inputs
 - Informal knowledge exchange

- Modifying existing data and indicators from the SDGs, Sendai Framework, or other relevant international sources
- Creating, distributing, and analyzing voluntary questionnaires or selfassessments
- Defining, negotiating, and/or implementing a standardized suite of indicators
- Conducting and aggregating indepth evaluative proximity-totarget analyses for each country
