Background and scope

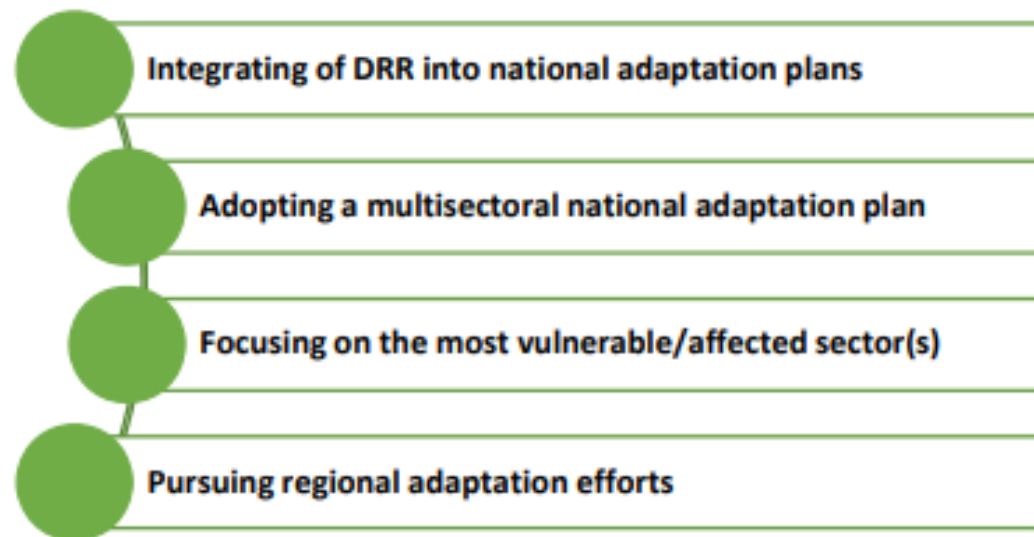
- CMA: Requested secretariat, under the guidance of the AC and the LEG, to prepare synthesis reports every two years starting in 2020 to cover specific adaptation themes and relevant lessons learned and good practices
- AC 16:
 - ✓ Agreed on theme for its first synthesis report: “How developing countries are addressing hazards, focusing on relevant lessons learned and good practices”
 - ✓ Requested the secretariat to develop an initial draft for consideration by AC 17
- Scope:
 - ✓ Identification of actions in response to climate hazards
 - ✓ Review of NAPs, NDCs, NCs, other relevant reports, including reports from the TEP-A, the AC, the LEG, and reports prepared under the NWP.
 - ✓ So far, 89 NDCs and 18 NAPs considered

3. Adaptation efforts by type of hazard (floods, droughts, sea level rise, storms and hurricanes) and by type of measure (strategies, plans, legal and regulatory frameworks, project implementation)
