### Background

The Paris Agreement sets out to limit global warming to less than 2 degrees above pre-industrial levels, with the preferable target of limiting warming to 1.5 degrees. The emission reductions required to achieve this goal are significant – global emissions will need to decline by about 45 per cent (on 2010 levels) by 2030 and be at net zero by 2050. Meeting this challenge will require system-level changes. While International Labour Organization (ILO) research shows that up to 14.2 million net green jobs can be achieved by 2030,<sup>1</sup> these jobs will not be generated automatically – we must learn to recognize the opportunities and design strategic policies and interventions, driven by respect for the environment, the Guidelines for a just transition towards environmentally sustainable economies and societies for all<sup>2</sup>, and the Decent Work Agenda.

To contribute to the commitment made in the High-Level Statement released at the United Nations Climate Action Summit in September 2019, the multilateral development banks (MDBs) have been collaborating on Just Transition. MDBs have a key role to play in supporting countries to pursue a just transition to deliver to climate and socio-economic outcomes, thereby accelerating delivery of the Paris Agreement and Sustainable Development Goals.

### Objectives

Hosted by the Asian Development Bank (ADB), ILO, and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, this session will examine some of the guidelines, principles, approaches, and financing mechanisms available to countries as they pursue a Just Transition to sustainable and low-carbon and climate-resilient communities. The session will discuss partnership initiatives, who is investing and who is financing what and why, as well as needs and opportunities for support in countries.
