




EXPLORE EXHIBITORS

How to find an exhibitor of interest

How to explore individual exhibitors

Once you have selected an exhibitor, you will find information about what the exhibitor does **C**, videos **D**, links to the organisation's website **E** and any additional information the organiser may feel is important to their cause **F**.

How to engage with exhibit organisers

Navigate to the 'Meet The Team' section of the exhibitor's page **G**. Click on the 'Schedule Meeting' button on the right **H** or click on 'Connect' to add the team members to your network **I**.
