## **Background and mandate**

- AC flexible workplan 2016-18 > advance activities on the engagement of the private sector (PS)
- AC 11 / AC 12 > mapping of actors (relevant literature); open survey of PS adaptation action and motivations -> Reports
- 2018 > workshop to advance activities on the engagement of the PS, and foster greater contribution of the PS:
  - Fostering engagement of the agri-food sector in resilience to climate change (ITC and UNFCCC in Geneva, Switzerland from 29-31 October 2018), supported by Germany, Japan and the EU
- AC flexible workplan 2019-21 > strengthen engagement with the private sector on mobilizing financial resources for adaptation action
- 2019 Adaptation Forum > Engagement of the private sector in adaptation planning processes, including NAPs: Challenges and opportunities (Korea Global Adaptation Week on 10 April in Songdo, Korea)
- TEM-A 2019 > Adaptation Finance, including the private sector (Bonn, 25-26 June 2019)
