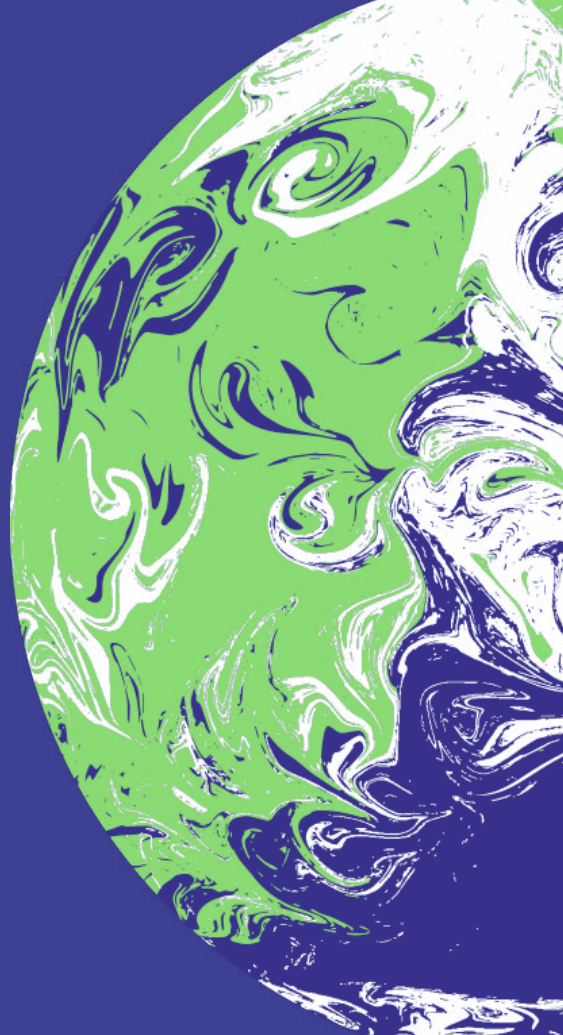

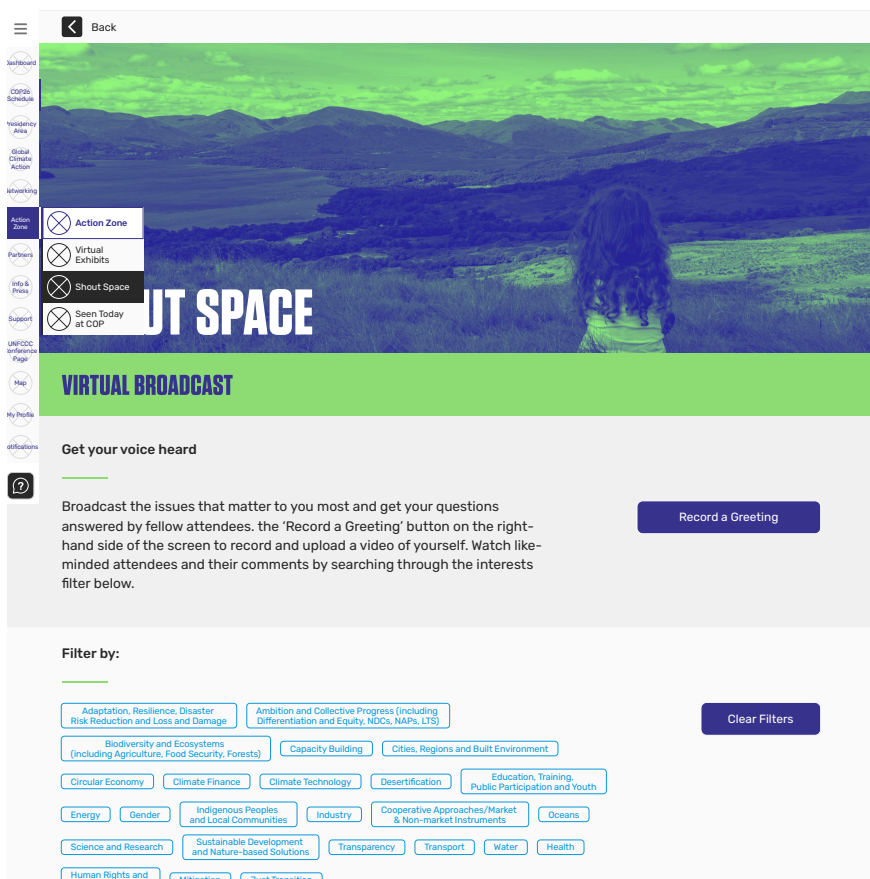
# CREATE A SHOUT SPACE VIDEO

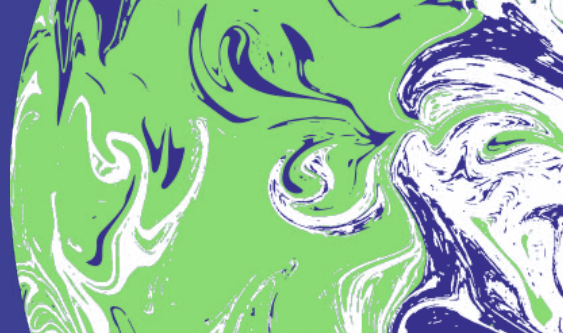
Click the filters at the top of the Shout Space or Seen Today at COP page to find videos from participants who have indicated the same areas of interest as you.

## How do I create a video?


You can create a video on either the Shout Space or Seen Today at COP page. Head to the right-hand side of the screen and click the 'Record a greeting' button.

## How do I delete a video?

Once you record a video, you will be asked whether you want to keep the video or delete it. If you decide to post a video and want to delete it at a later date, go to the Shout Space or Seen Today at COP page, hover over the video, and select the bin icon  on the right side of your video .
