**2022 - 2024**

Promote and facilitate implementation of the ETF, in particular, preparation and submission of BTRs under the ETF and NCs under the Convention

**2024 - 2026**

Gather lessons learned and good practices

Understand areas of improvement

Refine the approaches and tools used to provide technical advice and support

Continue facilitating implementation of the ETF, and preparation and submission of NCs

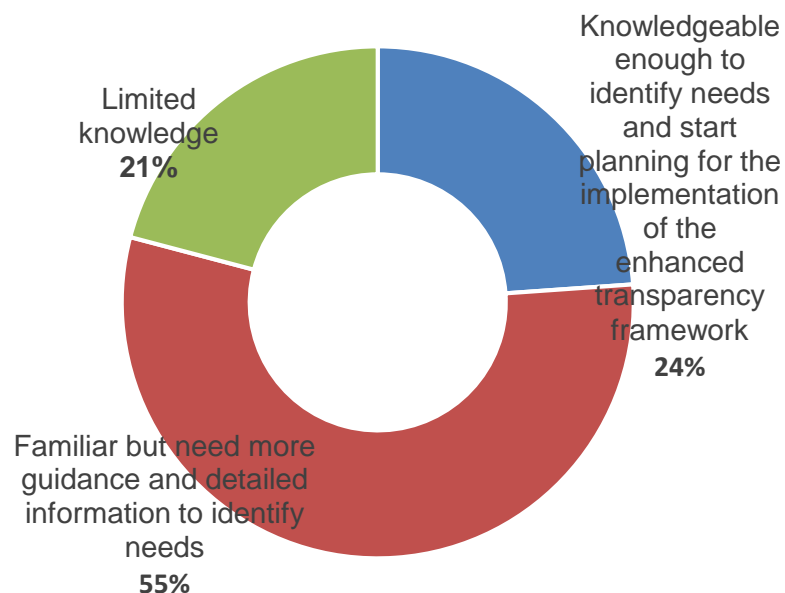

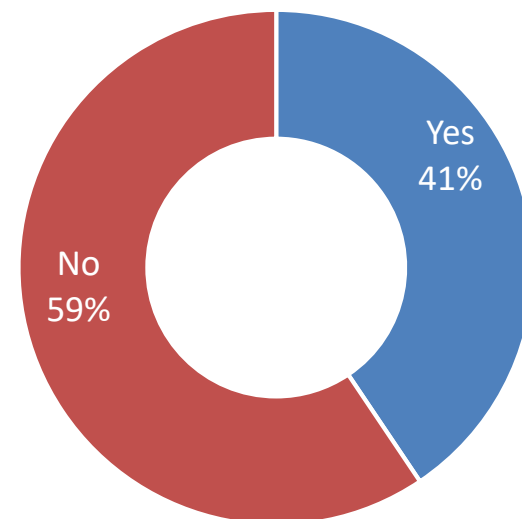
## 1. Level of knowledge in the MPGs for the ETF

## 2. Whether developing country Parties started planning for reporting under the enhanced transparency framework

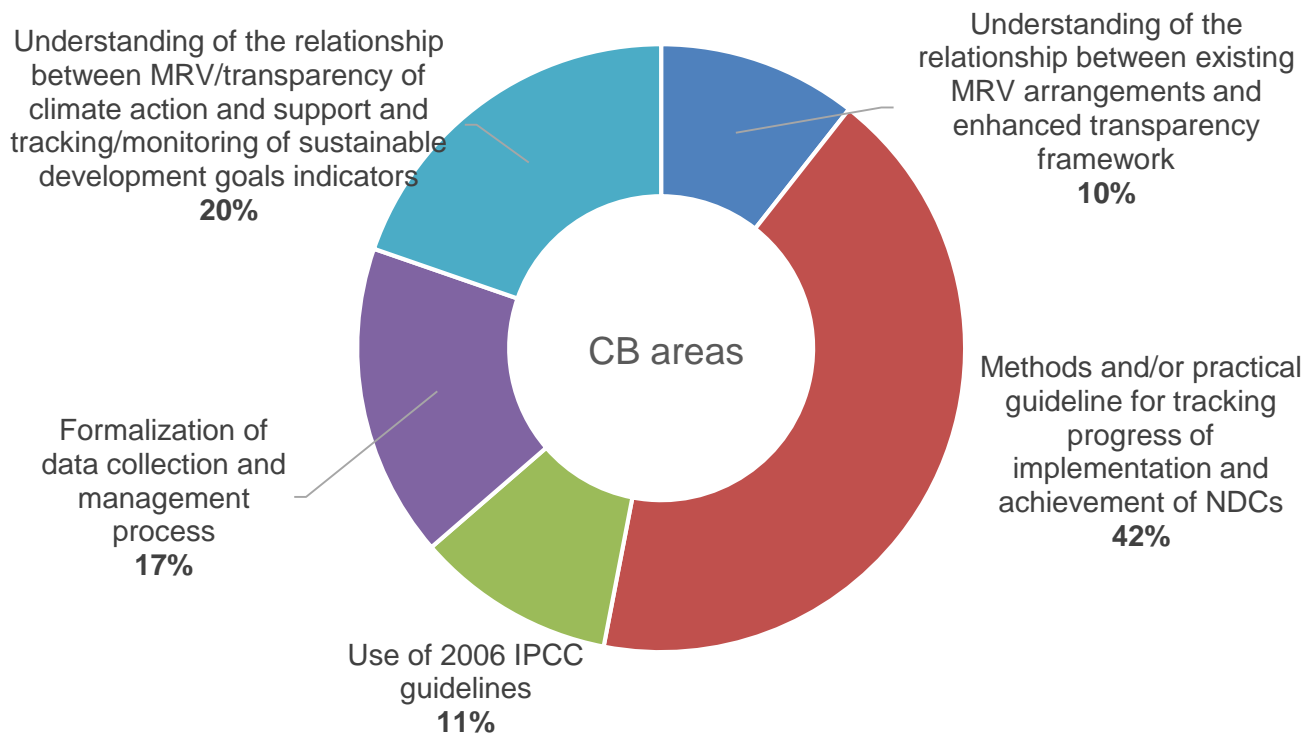
