To deliver:

- transparency and mutual trust in the emissions reductions achieved through Article 6
- The TACCC principles; transparency, accuracy, completeness, comparability, and consistency

Scope

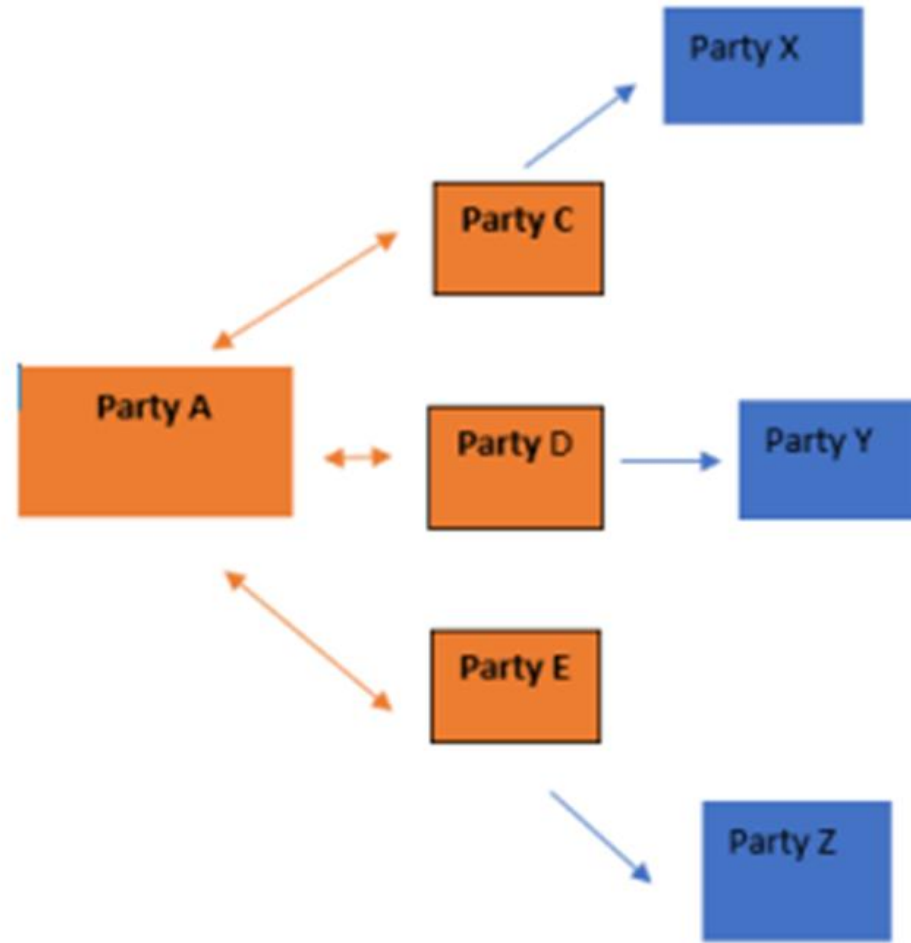
What is meant by ‘Consistency’

- Ensuring the information reported is complete and fully **consistent with the guidance**.
- Ensuring **consistency with the TACCC principles**, demonstrating traceability of the reported information
- Ensuring **consistency across the different reporting requirements** (Initial report, Annual Information, Regular Information, and the Biennial Transparency Report)
- Ensuring **consistency of reporting across Parties** engaging in the same cooperative approaches

Resourcing

- Robust resourcing to deliver scope of our proposal within allotted timeframes.
- Adequate Training
- Alignment with A13

Accountability

- Minimize burden on Parties and Secretariat
- Leveraging existing formats, infrastructure, and processes
