## What is meant by 'Consistency'


- Ensuring the information reported is complete and fully consistent with the guidance.
- Ensuring consistency with the TACCC principles, demonstrating traceability of the reported information
- Ensuring consistency across the different reporting requirements (Initial report, Annual Information, Regular Information, and the Biennial Transparency Report)
- Ensuring consistency of reporting across Parties engaging in the same cooperative approaches
