1. ► **Action:** The Co-Chair of the Article 6.4 mechanism Accreditation Expert Panel (hereinafter referred to as the AEP) shall open the eighth meeting of the AEP.

#### Agenda item 1.2. Adoption of the agenda

2. ► **Action:** The AEP may wish to adopt the proposed agenda of the eighth meeting.

*Background:* The agenda was drawn up based on the AEP workplan, version 01.0, which was published as an annex to the annotations of the Supervisory Body at its 20<sup>th</sup> meeting.<sup>1</sup>

3. ► **Action:** Members of the AEP may wish to provide statements on any potential conflict of interest concerning the issues on the agenda for the meeting and take action, as appropriate.

*Background:* In accordance with paragraph 28 of the “Terms of reference of the Article 6.4 mechanism expert panels”, members of a panel shall abide by the code of conduct of the Supervisory Body, as well as by the provisions related to conflict of interest and transparency of the Supervisory Body, taking into account specific confidentiality requirements. They shall declare whether they have a pecuniary or financial interest in an issue presented to them as a member of the panel, and if so, refrain from participating in any discussion or decision on the issue. Members of a panel shall not disclose any confidential or proprietary information that comes to their knowledge from serving on a panel.

*Background:* As part of the AEP workplan for 2026 (A6.4-SBM020-A02), the assessment of applications for accreditation, including the accreditation of new operational entities, is
