- Renewable energy generation, including utility-scale and distributed solar, wind, waste-to-energy, and other renewable energy technologies.
- Energy efficiency improvements in industrial facilities, buildings, district cooling systems, transport, and public infrastructure.
- Industrial decarbonization measures, including fuel switching, process optimization, electrification, low-carbon manufacturing, and deployment of best available technologies.
- Waste management activities, including landfill gas capture and utilization, methane avoidance, wastewater treatment improvements, circular economy initiatives, and waste-to-energy projects.
- Nature-based solutions and carbon removals, including mangrove restoration, afforestation, ecosystem restoration, blue carbon initiatives, and other eligible removals consistent with Article 6.4 methodologies and national policies.
- Other innovative mitigation technologies that support decarbonization and are consistent with future methodologies adopted under the Article 6.4 mechanism.
