| Communication Text <i>Include background, details, and conclusion</i> | <p>Dear Mr. Steleki and Ms. Ruesga,</p> <p>On behalf of the Project Developer Forum (PD Forum), we would like to express our appreciation for the Supervisory Body's continued efforts in operationalizing the Article 6.4 mechanism and for establishing procedures to enhance stakeholder engagement and transparency.</p> <p>The PD Forum represents a global network of more than 60 carbon project developers with extensive previous experience under the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) and voluntary carbon standards, plus active engagement in preparing methodologies and activities under the Article 6.4 mechanism and Article 6.2. Our members bring implementation-level insight across sectors, regions, and methodological approaches, and remain committed to supporting the development of a robust and scalable mechanism.</p> <p>We note that the Body's adopted Procedure for Direct Communication with Stakeholders (A6.4-PROC-GOV-007) provides multiple avenues for stakeholder engagement. In this context, the PD Forum would like to express its interest in establishing a structured and regular engagement channel with the Supervisory Body, complemented by a direct and operational engagement interface with the Methodological Expert Panel.</p> <p>1. Engagement with the Supervisory Body</p> <p>We would welcome the opportunity for more structured interaction with the Supervisory Body, for example through periodic dialogue on cross-cutting implementation challenges; and opportunities to provide consolidated input ahead of key regulatory or methodological decisions.</p> <p>Such engagement would support the Supervisory Body in identifying areas where regulatory clarification or adjustment may be needed to enhance both environmental integrity and practical implementation.</p> <p>2. Engagement with the Methodological Expert Panel (MEP)</p> <p>In line with Section 7.3 (paragraphs 46–49) of PACM's <i>Procedure: Direct communication with stakeholders</i>, the PD Forum would like to formally signal its interest in engaging with the MEP through a</p> |

| | <p>structured interaction channel, with the aim of providing consolidated, experience-based technical input on the development and application of PACM methodologies.</p> <p>We also note the precedent under the CDM, where dedicated practitioner working groups (e.g. the A&R working group) contributed to methodological refinement and implementation clarity.</p> <p>Given the scale and urgency of methodological development under the Article 6.4 mechanism, we believe that structured engagement between the Supervisory Body, its expert panels, and practitioner forums can materially enhance the clarity, robustness, and uptake of the regulatory framework, while improving practitioner capabilities to use the system.</p> <p>The PD Forum remains committed to supporting the Supervisory Body and its panels in delivering a credible, transparent, and scalable mechanism. We would welcome guidance on how best to operationalize such engagement.</p> |
