COVER NOTE

1. Procedural background

- 1. The support structure of the Supervisory Body of the Article 6.4 mechanism (hereinafter referred to as "the Supervisory Body") consisting of the Accreditation Expert Panel (AEP) and Methodological Expert Panel (MEP), is established under the Supervisory Body to assist in the performance of its functions related to the accreditation system and methodological issues concerning Article 6.4 mechanism activities.
- 2. The mandates of the panels are determined by their terms of reference, the rules of procedure of the Supervisory Body, and additional guidance provided by the Supervisory Body.
- 3. The 2024 workplan of the AEP outlines the expected tasks / products for consideration at each meeting throughout the year in support of the work of the Supervisory Body. It has been developed within the context of the Article 6.4 mechanism's two-year business and resource allocation plan 2024–2025. The workplan includes routine operational activities as well as mandates from the Supervisory Body.
- 4. The workplan provides information regarding tasks to be performed / products to be considered by the AEP at each meeting. The type of products included in the workplan indicate the actions to be taken by the AEP as outlined in table 1 below:
