1. Introduction

1. The support structure of the Supervisory Body of the Article 6.4 mechanism consisting of the Accreditation Expert Panel (AEP) and Methodological Expert Panel is established under the Supervisory Body to assist in the performance of its functions related to the accreditation system and methodological issues concerning Article 6.4 mechanism activities.
2. The mandates of the panels are determined by their terms of reference, the rules of procedure of the Supervisory Body, and additional guidance provided by the Supervisory Body.
3. The 2026 workplan of the AEP outlines the expected tasks / products for consideration at each meeting throughout the year in support of the work of the Supervisory Body. It has been developed within the context of the Article 6.4 mechanism's two-year business and resource allocation plan 2026–2027.¹ The workplan includes routine operational activities as well as mandates from the Supervisory Body.
