### I: Introduction and background

- 2020 event for sharing existing knowledge on, and tools for, M&E
- 2021 Technical paper, based on case studies

### Agreed themes for event:

- Communicating M&E results;
- > Sharing existing knowledge and tools on measuring progress of adaptation actions, also addressing data.



### II: Overview

Event was scheduled during Adaptation Futures 2020 conference, New Delhi, India (postponed to October 2021).

#### The document recalls:

- Previous and ongoing AC work on M&E
- The preparations for the event,
- Possible next steps regarding the event and the development of the technical paper.

## Update since the concept note was discussed:

- > Time allocation of only 1 slot à 90 min instead of 2 slots à 3 hours
- Part III (Masterclass) therefore cancelled and integrated as inputs into parts I and II instead



### III. Next steps

In light of COVID19-related delays and ongoing AC work on thematically related CMA mandates, the AC may wish to consider if and how it wishes to proceed with the planned next steps:

#### >Event:

- ➤ 2019 concept as contained in the annex (parts I and II) still valid and desirable?
- ➤ Does AC still wish to hold the event?
- ➤ If yes, request secretariat to contact the partner organizations on their availability, and the Adaptation Futures steering committee to explore possibilities to hold the event in the new setup of Adaptation Futures.
- ➤ Technical paper: Workplan foresees the paper to feature case studies on the development and application of M&E systems at various levels.
  - ➤Paper still needed and desirable?
  - ➤ If so, which levels should be addressed in the call for case studies (local/subnational/national/ regional?).
  - Include technical paper in new workplan for the years 2022-2024.
