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NOTIFICATION TO PARTIES AND OBSERVER STATES

Thirtieth meeting of the Adaptation Committee

**14–17 September 2026
Baku, Azerbaijan**

Pursuant to decisions 1/CP.16 and 2/CP.17, I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, that the thirtieth meeting of the Adaptation Committee (AC) will take place from **14 to 17 September 2026 in Baku, Azerbaijan**.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.17, the meeting of the Adaptation Committee will be open to observers, except where otherwise decided by the Adaptation Committee. The initial half-day of the meeting is reserved for an internal stocktake by AC members. Observer attendance will commence **at 14:00 on Monday, 14 September 2026**, and continue through **Thursday, 17 September 2026**.

To register representatives for the meeting, National Focal Points (NFPs) of interested Parties and observer States should email their request to ac@unfccc.int. Nominations of representatives received from other persons or Groups will need to be endorsed by their respective NFP. Following the nomination or the endorsement by the NFP, a registration link, together with instructions for completing the registration form, will be provided to the nominated representatives. Provisions for virtual participation will be in place. The meeting will also be broadcast via YouTube.

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The deadline for registration as an observer is **Friday, 21 August 2026**. Please be advised that the secretariat may not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
