#### Background

Organized by UN Climate Change in collaboration with the Youth Non-Governmental Organization constituency (YOUNGO), the thematic will take place at COP 25 on 5 December, with youth-led side events, workshops and activities that show how the youth are leading climate action.

Thursday, 5 December 2019 10:00 – 10:45 Rapa Nui-Action Hub Madrid, Spain

The day will start with an opening ceremony, followed later by the Intergenerational Inquiry, which will provide a platform for youth and decision makers to discuss how young people can enhance implementation of the Paris Agreement. The day will close with the Award Ceremony of the Global Youth Video Competition, which will showcase the winners of the 2019 edition of the competition.

The events throughout Young and Future Generations Day are open for participation by young leaders, youth organizations, civil society, the private sector, UN agencies, practitioners and media accredited at COP 25.
