Report of the Adaptation Committee
Version 12/11/2022 18:00**

The SBSTA and the SBI recommend the following draft decision on this matter for consideration by COP 27 and CMA 4, respectively.

[The COP and the CMA:

1. Welcome the work of the Adaptation Committee in 2022 and take note of the report of the Adaptation Committee for 2022 and the recommendations contained therein;¹
2. Welcome the submissions from Parties on the progress, effectiveness and performance of the Adaptation Committee;²
3. The COP concludes the review of the progress, effectiveness and performance of the Adaptation Committee, in line with decisions 5/CP.22, paragraphs 11 and 12;
4. The CMA endorses decision -/CP.27 on the review of the progress, effectiveness and performance of the Adaptation Committee in line with decision 2/CP.26, paragraph 8;
5. Request the Adaptation Committee to consider how the submissions and the views referred to in paragraph 2 above can be taken into account in implementing its flexible workplans, in line with its mandate, and to reflect on possible steps to be taken in this regard in its 2023 annual report;
6. The COP decides to review the progress, effectiveness and performance of the Adaptation Committee at its thirty-second session (2027), with a view to adopting a decision on the basis of the outcome of that review;
7. The COP invites the CMA at its ninth session (2027), as provided in decision 11/CMA.1, to participate in the review referred to in paragraph 6 above it relates to the Paris Agreement;
8. Invites Parties to submit via the submission portal, no later than three months prior to the thirty-second session (2027) of the Conference of the Parties and the ninth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement, their views on the progress, effectiveness and performance of the Adaptation Committee and on the review process referred to in paragraph 6 above with a view to informing that process;
9. Request the AC to make the draft supplementary guidance for voluntary use by Parties on adaptation communications available by March 2023 with adjustments to be reflected in the proceedings of the reports of the COP and the CMA.
