



# Call for Loan of Expert to the United Nations Climate Change Secretariat Bonn

## Loan of Expert

The United Nations Climate Change Secretariat (UNFCCC) is seeking the non-reimbursable loan of the following Expert from Parties or other organizations for an initial period of one year through its Non-Reimbursable Loan (NRL) programme.

<b>Duration:</b>	12 months, with possibility of extension
<b>Date required:</b>	As soon as possible
<b>Duty Station:</b>	Bonn, Germany
<b>Organizational Setting:</b>	Adaptation Programme, UNFCCC

## Responsibilities

Under the guidance of the Director, Adaptation Programme, the Expert will perform the following duties:

- ✓ Assist in the preparation and successful delivery of mandated meetings and intersessional events and side events;
- ✓ Contribute to resource mobilization efforts from potential donors;
- ✓ Perform other related duties, as required.

## Qualifications & Requirements

**Academic:** Advanced university degree (Master's degree or higher) in economics, social sciences, environmental studies, natural sciences, engineering, development studies, or a related field.

**Experience:** At least five years experience working at a professional level on climate change, and at least two years experience in the area of Indigenous Peoples issues, knowledge systems, and rights (these can be in addition to the five years on climate change, or in conjunction). Strong English drafting skills on policy and technical papers. Demonstrated record of providing technical expertise to governments or organizations. Experience in adaptation would be an advantage.

**Languages:** Fluency in written and oral English is required. Working knowledge of other UN official languages is an advantage.
