The United Nations Climate Change Secretariat (UNFCCC) is seeking the non-reimbursable loan of the following Expert from Parties or other organizations for an initial period of one year through its Non-Reimbursable Loan (NRL) programme.

Responsibilities

Under the guidance of the Director, Adaptation Programme, and the supervision of the manager of the Cross cutting support and outreach sub-programme, the Expert will perform the following duties:

- ✓ Provide technical support to Parties through supporting the work of the UNFCCC Adaptation Committee, including on adaptation action and promoting finance, technology and capacity building for adaptation;
- ✓ Undertake activities in support of the Technical Examination Process on Adaptation;
- ✓ Support stakeholder engagement and outreach activities of the Adaptation Committee;
- ✓ Perform other related duties, as required.

Qualifications & Requirements

Academic: Advanced university degree (Master's degree or higher) in economics, social sciences, environmental studies, natural sciences, engineering, development studies, or a related field.

Experience: At least five years of experience in technical aspects of climate change adaptation, sustainable development, economics, with strong English drafting skills on policy and technical papers. Demonstrated record of providing technical expertise to governments or international organizations would be an advantage.

Languages: Fluency in written and oral English is required. Working knowledge of other UN official languages is an advantage.
