## Conference Room Paper from the African Group of Negotiators (AGN) Baku, 13 November 2024

*Review of the progress, effectiveness and performance of the Adaptation Committee* SBSTA 5 (c)/SBI 11 (c)

Draft Decision text

The Conference of the Parties

Recalling Articles 3 and 4 of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change,

Also recalling decisions 1/CP.16 paragraph 20, and 11/CMA.1 paragraph 1,

Further recalling decisions 5/CP.22 paragraph 11, and 2/CP.26, paragraph 8,

*Recognizes* the progress, effectiveness and performance of the Adaptation Committee in implementing its mandate since the review of the Committee in 2016 and its central role in promoting the implementation of enhanced action on adaptation in a coherent manner.

*Welcomes* the Adaptation Committee reports on its achievements in the implementation of its flexible workplan 2022-2024, despite the scarcity of the financial resources to support it work and activities.

*Requests* the Adaptation Committee to continue explore ways and means that will allow improving further its effectiveness and performances.

*Also requests* the Adaptation Committee to determine the modalities on the participation of the CMA in the review of the Adaptation Committee as it related to the Paris Agreement, to ensure smooth and productive future reviews of its progress, effectiveness and performance.

*Urges* Developed Country Parties to the Convention, in particular Annex II Parties, to scale-up the provision of financial support and resources for the work and activities of the Adaptation Committee, in particular its flexible workplan 2025-27.

*Decides* that the next and subsequent reviews of the progress, effectiveness and performance of the Adaptation Committee be conducted each three (03) years, in accordance with the three years timeframe of its flexible workplans, and adjusted accordingly.
