Day 1: Long term planning and national commitments (NDCs, LTLEDS)

The sessions to be organized under this theme may include but are not limited to ambitious climate action and long-term climate plans covered in the region's NDCs and/or long-term low GHG emission strategies; implementation of NDCs/LTEDS, including with support.

Day 2: Climate information, tracking progress and monitoring
The sessions to be organized under this theme may include but are not limited to governments reporting/tracking under the Paris Agreement; subnational climate reporting; non-Party disclosure of climate information; and the use of data for climate ambition

The sessions to be organized under this theme may include but are not limited to integrated (long-term) national planning and integrated national policy making; whole-of-government and society approaches for implementing climate action; and enhanced engagement of all stakeholders.

### Day 3: Nature-based solutions/Making peace with nature

The sessions to be organized under this theme may include but are not limited to ambitious actions in key sectors, including nature-based solutions that are aligned with environmental limits; scaling up nature-based solutions; developing a common vision for land, climate and biodiversity.

The sessions to be organized under this theme may include but are not limited to integrated approaches that address the climate challenge while enable recovery from the COVID19 pandemic; carbon pricing; finance regulations; just transition issues; and SDG alignment.

Day 1: Reinforcing climate resilience through integrated climate solutions

- Themes to be included in Track 2 Day 1 may include but are not limited to:

  Ambitions for climate action in the region
- Opportunities in NDCs and NAPs for climate resilience
- UN approaches to integrated climate solutions
- Climate resilient COVID-19 recovery

Day 2: Integrated support for acceleration of climate resilience: from assessment to the design and implementation of programmes Themes to be included in Track 2 Day 2 may include but are not exclusive to:

- Scaling up nature-based solutions
- Fostering climate resilient blue economy
- Scaling up opportunities for enhancing climate resilient food systems
- Enhancing urban resilience

Day 3: Partnerships and collaboration for integrated and inclusive climate resilient development Themes to be included in Track 2 Day 3 may include but are not exclusive to:

- Scientific knowledge and collaboration with local partners for a climate resilient society
- Youth empowerment for climate action
- Social inclusivity and inequality lenses on climate finance
- Gender-responsive climate action

This may include, but is not limited to, sessions on:

accelerating the development and deployment of innovative technology and design to decarbonize build

policies for market transformation, behavioral change and urban planning; and finance and business transformations for climate-resilient cities.

This will include, but not limited to, sessions on;

scaling-up the deployment of e-mobility and enhancing the development of innovative technologies nee policies for market transformation, behavioral change and modal shift; and

- finance and business transformations for zero emission transport.

## Day 3: Sustainable Energy

This will include, but not limited to, sessions on:

- accelerating the deployment of existing zero emission energy supply, the deployment of innovative technolicies for market transformation, behavioral change and energy efficiency; and
- finance and business transformations needed for zero emission energy.

The selected Side Events and Action Hub videos will be added in the official programme of the climate week after the Eol process is closed.

The selected events/organizations will need to be responsible for hosting and delivering the the event in its own platform.

The RCW platform will publish the link to the selected event so that the interested participants will click on the link and automatically be transferred to the platform of the Side Events
