Day 2: Multi-level governance

The sessions to be organized under this theme may include but are not limited to integrated (long-term) national planning and integrated national policy making; whole-of-government and society approaches for implementing climate action; and enhanced engagement of all stakeholders.

Day 3: Nature-based solutions/Making peace with nature

The sessions to be organized under this theme may include but are not limited to ambitious actions in key sectors, including nature-based solutions that are aligned with environmental limits; scaling up nature-based solutions; developing a common vision for land, climate and biodiversity.

Day 3: Aligning policy signals

The sessions to be organized under this theme may include but are not limited to integrated approaches that address the climate challenge while enable recovery from the COVID19 pandemic; carbon pricing; finance regulations; just transition issues; and SDG alignment.

Day 3: Partnerships and collaboration for integrated and inclusive climate resilient development

Themes to be included in Track 2 Day 3 may include but are not exclusive to:

- Youth empowerment for climate action
- Social inclusivity and inequality lenses on climate finance
- Gender-responsive climate action

- finance and business transformations for zero emission transport.

Day 3: Sustainable Energy

This will include, but not limited to, sessions on:

- accelerating the deployment of existing zero emission energy supply, the deployment of innov
- policies for market transformation, behavioral change and energy efficiency; and
- finance and business transformations needed for zero emission energy.
