Climate Storytellers Collective:

Building communication capacity using your story to empower climate action.

Background:

At COP26, members of the Climate Storytellers Collective will present their climate stories through a participatory model of diversity voice inclusion - both in person and virtually - to share experiences of creating capacity-building stories. Our session will foster awareness and action of justice as it relates to climate mitigation and adaptation efforts. We will touch on how our Climate Storytellers workshop series, a collaboration between CLEAR Environmental, Digital Storytellers and the PCCB Network, provides an equitable and just space using freely available tools, for global climate storytellers to convene, build a network, and share emerging challenges and solutions in the context of their own capacity building related to climate change work.

The Climate Storytellers Collective, the emerging network built from the PCCB Network workshop series, now supports further capacity building and spreading of storytelling in multiple media forms. We will also provide resources for those interested to explore all of the stories created, related resources, and to join in the Climate Storytellers Collective.

Objectives:

- The tools and open source educational resources (OER) to produce their own climate story that can be included and highlighted on the Climate Storytellers Collective [webspace](#)
- Access to a network they can join to build capacity by interacting and sharing stories with peers and colleagues who are doing similar work in different parts of the world leading to opportunities of globally shared resources.
- Support to produce a policy brief using an OER template, written by our organization, that could lead to organizational change within their local government
- Examples of powerful stories that can engage communities, stakeholders and spark action
