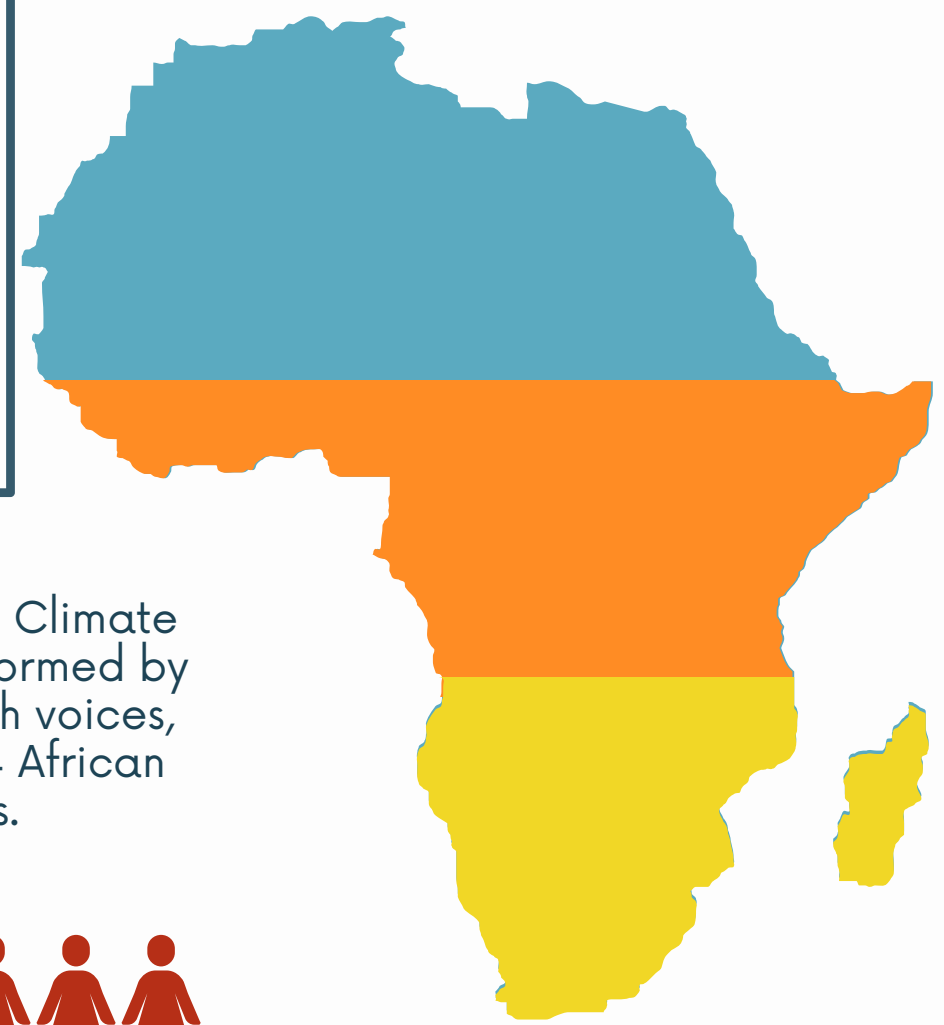
Africa Youth Climate Action Plan

A unified African youth voice through a co-created action plan

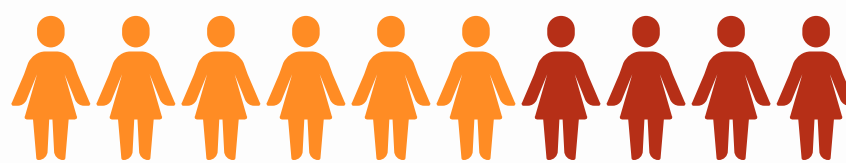
Each year, young people convene and develop their list of demands ahead of the Conference of Parties and not much attention is given to how those demands are translated into tangible actions in national climate change response plans and whether those actions are effectively being implemented. This makes it challenging for young people to hold the government accountable. As a result, **young Africans developed the Africa Youth Climate Action Plan (2022) that serves as an accountability mechanism by monitoring and evaluating the implementation of priority actions that have been enlisted in the action plan. The AYCAP includes actions directed at the government as well as commitments made by young Africans to advance climate action. 25 actions has been selected as priority actions and have been assigned a performance indicator that will be tracked over a period of 5 years. This data will inform the annual assessment reports will be presented at the Conference of Parties.**



“Through policy advocacy, the narrative is strengthened that young Africans aren't only mere beneficiaries but are agents of change who is at the forefront of Africa's climate change and development response.”



The Africa Youth Climate Action Plan is informed by 551 African youth voices, representing 54 African countries.



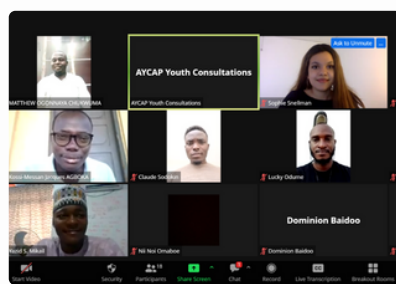

AYCAP DEVELOPMENT TIMELINE



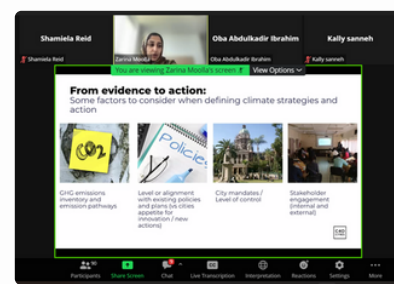
AFRICA CLIMATE WEEK 2022
1 September 2022

The AYCAP data collection process officially kicked off at YOUNGO's Youth and Green Futures event that took place at the Africa Climate Week in Gabon.



REGIONAL CONSULTATIONS
10 - 17 September 2022

Dedicated regional youth consultations were hosted in Central, East, North, South and West Africa. The consultations was followed up with 3 surveys to gather input at the individual level.



AYCAP WORKSHOP
26 September

AYM4COP facilitated the support from C40 Cities to capacitate 127 young Africans in climate action planning and M&E. English to French translation was organised to ensure meaningful participation of Francophone youth.



RCOY-AFRICA & BEYOND
14 - 16 October 2022

The first draft of the AYCAP was shared widely with African youth and RCOY-Africa participants to review and validate the content.
