BACKGROUND

The Global stocktake (GST) assesses collective progress towards the purpose and long-term goals of the Paris Agreement in a comprehensive and facilitative manner, considering mitigation, adaptation and the means of implementation and support (MOI), in the light of equity and the best available science. The GST will also consider the social and economic consequences of response measures and efforts to address loss and damage

The GST is an inclusive Party-driven process with the participation of all stakeholders.

THE EVENT

This GST event is an opportunity to engage stakeholders in the GST process. It will provide information on opportunities to participate in the GST and emphasize the importance of the GST as a process to increase climate action and support at all levels.

The event will aim to:

- Share information on the modalities and status of work on GST1 in assessing collective progress towards the purpose and long-term goals of the Paris Agreement, with a view to informing the updating and enhancing of NDCs (action and support), as well as international cooperation for climate change;
- Provide an opportunity to discuss the challenges, barriers, solutions and opportunities for climate action and support within the context of Africa; and
- Share information on the opportunities for contributing to the GST1 process by Parties and NPS.
