**Background:** At the Glasgow Conference, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA) adopted decision 4/CMA.3 on the Work programme under the framework for non-market approaches referred to in Article 6, paragraph 8, of the Paris Agreement. In paragraph 8(a) of that decision, the CMA requested the secretariat to organize an insession workshop, with the broad participation of relevant experts, on matters related to the call for submissions in paragraph 6 of the decision.

**Topic:** Matters related to the views and information on the call for submissions referred to in paragraph 6 of decision 4/CMA.3, including:

- 1. Existing non-market approaches in the initial focus areas;
- 2. Examples of potential additional focus areas and related existing non-market approaches;
- 3. UNFCCC web-based platform;
- 4. Schedule for implementing the work programme activities.

**Structure of the workshop:** The workshop will be opened by the Chair of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and be facilitated by two workshop co-facilitators invited by the SBSTA Chair. The workshop will allow time for presentations by interested Parties or observers, questions & answers, as well as for discussion (see table below).

The guiding questions for the discussion only aim to support focused interventions and interactive exchange on topics related to the call for submissions as listed above. Parties and observers may choose to address any or all of the questions, as well as any other matters they consider relevant to the topics.

**Further steps:** The Glasgow Committee on Non-market Approaches is mandated to develop and recommend a schedule for implementing the work programme activities, including specifications for the UNFCCC web-based platform for consideration and adoption by CMA 4 (November 2022). As requested by decision 4/CMA.3, the synthesis report on the submissions will be considered by the Glasgow Committee at its 1<sup>st</sup> meeting, to be held at this June session; and a report on the workshop will be prepared for consideration by the Glasgow Committee at its 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting (November 2022).
