BACKGROUND

This event will focus on the 25 years of work of the UNFCCC since its entry into force.

The UNSG convened the Summit with the aim of boosting ambition and accelerating actions to implement the Paris Agreement. He has called on all leaders to come to the Summit with concrete and realistic plans to enhance their nationally determined contributions by 2020, in line with reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 45 per cent over the next decade, and to net zero emissions by 2050.

Objective of the event:

The side event will focus on the 25 years of work of the UNFCCC and the way forward, noting that the efforts made by Parties and other stakeholders have established a solid foundation to address climate change.
