Her main professional and personal motivation is to promote just financial inclusion and governance.

Previously she worked as a researcher in the Overseas Development Institute based in London and later as a research consultant for more than 20 institutions including Indonesia's Ministry of Finance, OECD, and UNFCCC. She earned her PhD in International Development in 2014 from the University of East Anglia in the UK and published a series of research articles focusing on the determinants of global climate mitigation finance provision and allocation.
