2. Strengthening dialogue, coordination, coherence and synergies among relevant stakeholders.

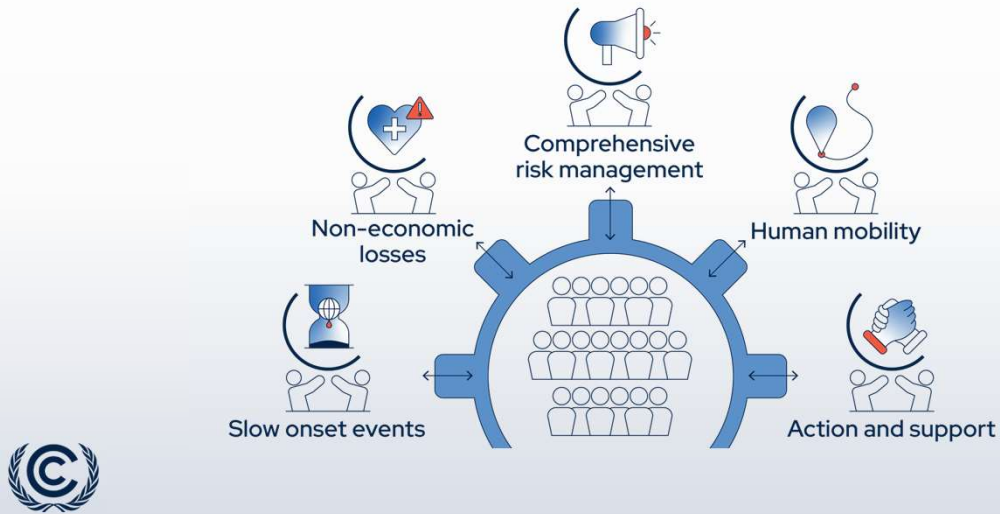


3. Enhancing action and support, including, finance, technology and capacity-building.

Thematic expert groups

- The WIM ExCom implements its work plan through coordination and collaboration with various stakeholders, including its thematic expert groups.
- Each expert group develops a **Plan of Action (PoA)**, to guide the planning and implementation of its work, which is endorsed by the WIM ExCom.
- The WIM ExCom has established **five thematic expert groups**. Each expert group includes 4 ExCom members serving as facilitators of the expert group.
