ARIUSA is a network of environmental university networks in Latin America, the Caribbean and Spain that promotes the commitment of universities to the environment and sustainability.

This alliance was created in 2007 by 6 networks with 90 higher education institutions.

Currently ARIUSA has 26 networks and 442 universities in 18 countries of the region.













The main recommendation on future work to enhance ACE implementation is:

To promote greater articulation of ACE with universities and other higher education institutions (HEIs) committed to concrete actions on climate change.











Universities and other IES can make significant contributions:

- To bring education and awareness of a large population of young university students on various issues related to climate change.
- To offer training at higher education level to students and professionals from various disciplines on climate change issues.
- To develop scientific research on many different aspects and problems of climate change in Latin America and the Caribbean.
- To participate with communities in projects directly related to climate change and related challenges.
- To collaborate with National Focal Points to implement ACE in each country.
