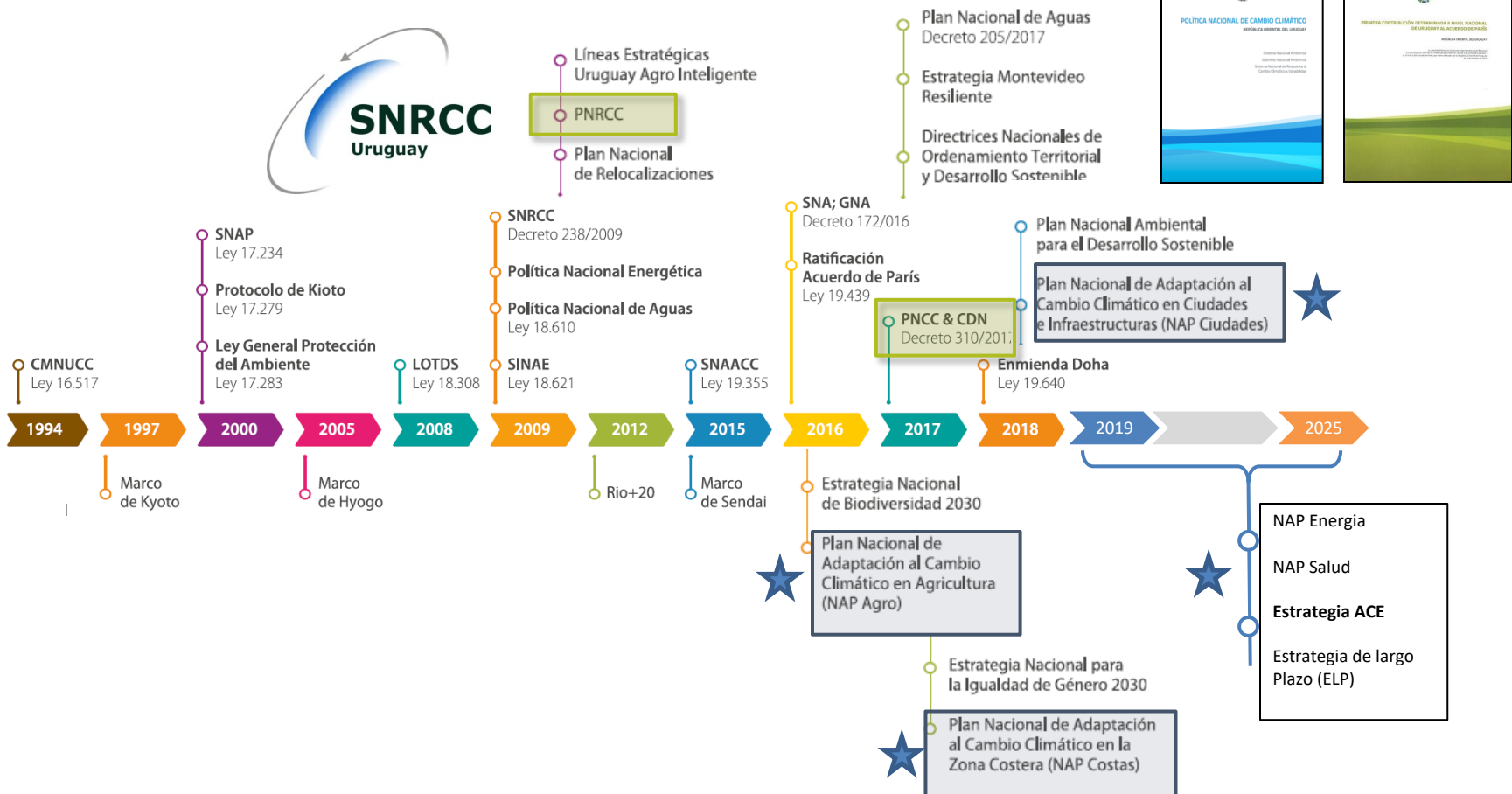

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Climate Change in Uruguay



ACE, the National Climate Change Policy and the NDC



- Formal education: training for teachers (ANEP, UdelaR) and students (Science Clubs, among others).
- Non-formal education: experiences from NGOs for local empowerment with education institutions and local and communities
- Local governments: climate change and human rights for adaptation in cities.
- Strengthening agricultural capacities for adaptation
- Training processes for different audiences (communicators, general public) to understand the climate change
- Awareness: audiovisual material on adaptation and mitigation

Opportunities towards ACE Strategy in Uruguay

SNRCC Working Group on Education and Awareness

NDC

- Strengthening of public, private, academic and NGOs for the participation and coordination of the planning and implementation of measures.
- Preparation and implementation of a training strategy, education in the formal and non-formal fields, and awareness raising that contributes to the implementation of the NDC and the empowerment of populations on risk management.
- Strengthening of scientific-technical exchange networks to carry out L&D and innovation projects at the national and regional level.
