NAP-NDC Linkages

What is the main link?

- **Adaptation component of NDCs: Goal-setting**
 - *Sets out the high-level vision, objectives and needs a country hopes to address through its adaptation efforts*
- **NAPs: Vehicle for A-NDC implementation**
 - *Country-driven, national-level processes to integrate adaptation into planning and implement adaptation priorities articulated in NDCs*

Why make the link?

- Raise the profile of adaptation – political support, resourcing
- Leverage all of the experience, expertise, investments in AD
- Streamline, coordinate, avoid duplication
- Explore AD-MIT links

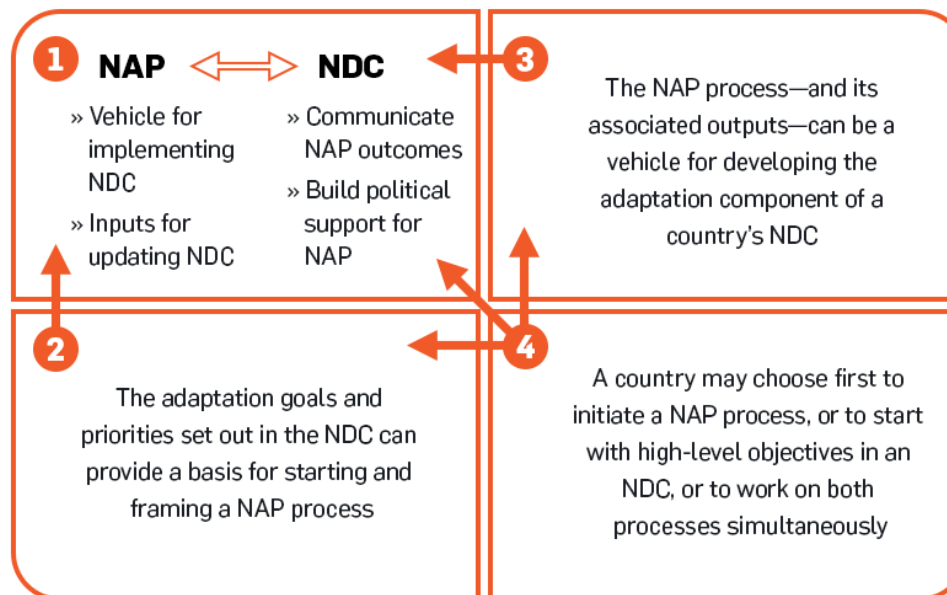

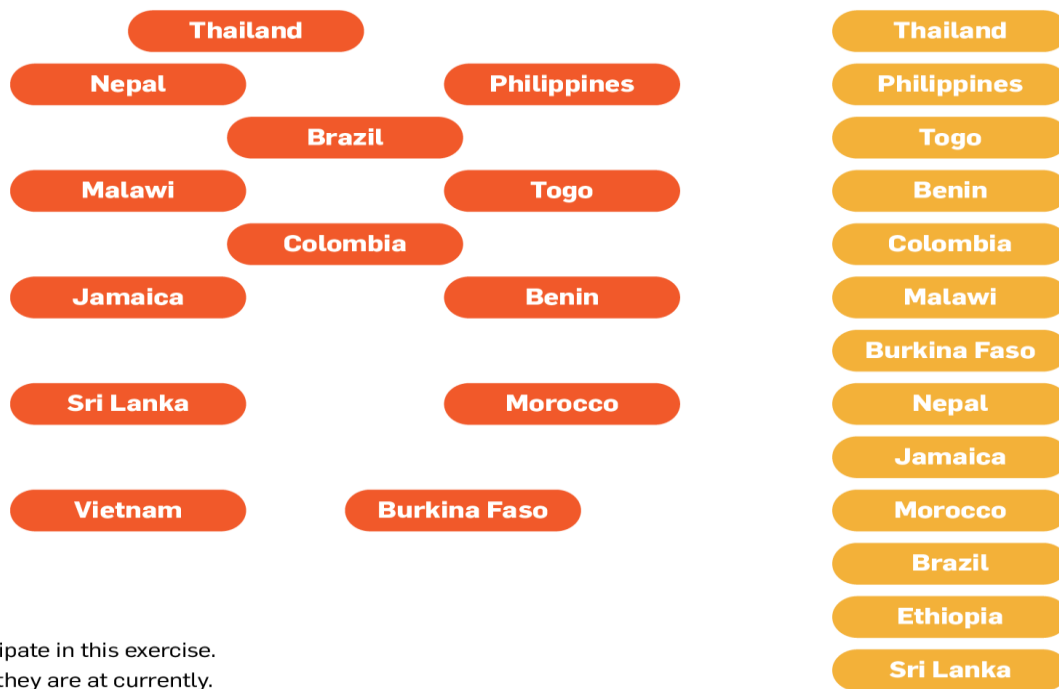
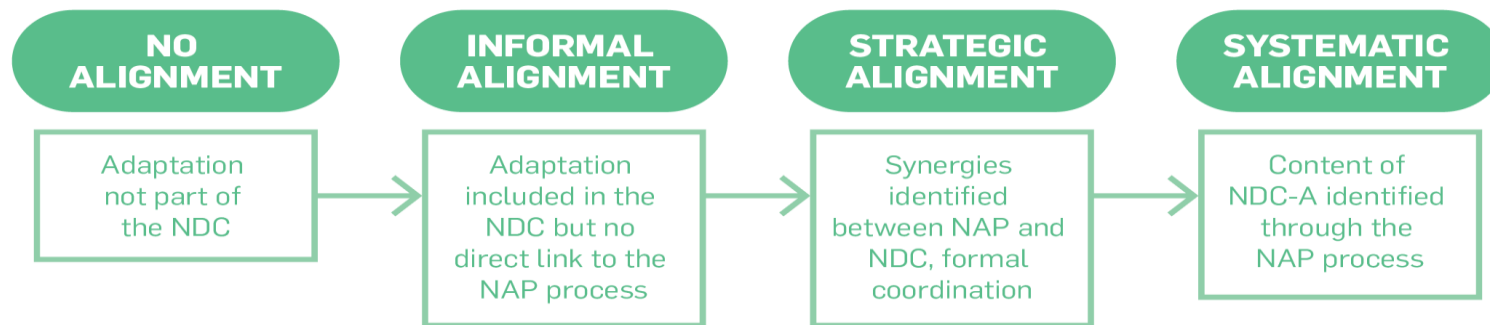
The NAP process is well underway

How can a synergetic approach to NAPs and NDCs support climate finance strategies?

- Finance strategies could provide important **entry point for alignment** – budgetary planning
- Streamline, **coordinate, avoid duplication** of efforts for **efficient use** of climate finance
- **Raise the profile of adaptation** – for political support, resourcing, leverage **additional funding**
- **Additional access** to climate finance sources by contributing to multiple global goals
