Karima Oustadi is an environmental economist with over eight years of experience in climate finance, transparency and environmental policy. She currently works as a civil servant at the Ministry of Environment and Energy Security, serving as Alternate Board Member for Italy in the Fund to Respond to Losses and Damages (FRLD), Vice-Chair of the OECD DAC subsidiary body EnviroNet, and as a member of the UNFCCC Standing Committee on Finance. She's been contributing to significant files within the Ministry, including the national report on the status of natural capital in Italy, the national environmental subsidies inventory, G7 and G20 Presidencies on climate change related issues. In the UNFCCC space, she's lead author of the Italian National Communication, Biennial Reports and Biennial Transparency Report for the financial support chapters, and served as a reviewer in the IAR process. She also supports the coordination of the technical team of European climate finance negotiators in the UNFCCC, focusing on aligning financial flows to climate goals.

Her experience includes roles at the Ministry of Economy and Finance of Italy, where she contributed to the analysis of development cooperation policies. Karima holds a master's degree in economics from the University of Trento (Italy), receiving recognition for her research work, and has carried out work experience at the OECD Centre for Local Development. She is actively involved in environmental awareness initiatives, chairing a local NGO dedicated to ecosystem conservation.
