

Australian submission GGA item Saturday 10 June

On the procedural draft text, we would like to see Norway's Paris Agreement point reflected. We would also like to see the EU updates/deletions to the procedural paragraphs.

Australia suggests the remaining content be annexed as an information note using the following headings. Please note these headings are not an outline for CMA 5 decision text, but instead are provided to capture thinking and inform remaining workshops under the GlaSS.

1. Framework purpose
2. Framework structure
3. Enabling conditions
4. Guidance for GST1
5. Review of framework before GST2

Australia sees exploring these areas and synthesising positions in an informal note as the best use of our time at SB 58 given where we are up to in the GlaSS (work program). A focus on the framework structure at a high level would be very useful as differences exist even within the G77. We therefore do not see the sense in listing targets and indicators as their context and purpose will not be clear.
