

PCCB Network Consultation session at COP25

- The PCCB Network Consultation took place on December 4, 2019 during the [2nd Capacity-building Hub](#) at COP25, in Madrid and was open to all Parties and registered observers.
- Moderated by members of the PCCB, the event was attended by 45 participants, represent a rich diversity of institutions, sectors, and regions. The session included a preliminary mapping exercise and discussion station on three station discussions on **‘Experiences and Recommendations’, ‘Procedures and Communications’,** and **‘Value Propositions and Expectations’**. All the inputs were integrated into an actionable implementation plan for the 1-year pilot phase of the PCCB Network in 2020.

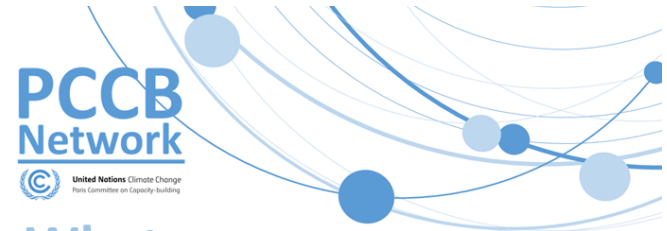
