

What is ACE about?

- The Climate Change Convention Article 6 and the Paris Agreement Article 12 emphasize the need to educate and inform people appropriately about climate change.
- Improving awareness and understanding of climate change, and creating solutions to facilitate access to information on a changing climate are key to winning public support for climate-related policies, as well to foster the implementation of adaptation and mitigation actions.

What is the goal?

- The over-arching goal of ACE is to empower <u>all members of society</u> to engage in climate action, through its six elements.
- Last COP25 in Madrid had been also about outreach and inclusion of non**state actors.** These stakeholders are a vital part of the global communities' efforts to achieve the climate goals.
- Such broad collaboration between all levels of government and all sectors of society is required to get a transformation to more sustainable lifestyles.

Pamhagen ACE conference & Burgenland Declaration

The ACE symposium in Pamhagen brought together ACE national focal points, representatives from governments, the private sector, local and regional authorities, youth who discussed how to catalyse wider engagement in, and support to, implementation of the ACE agenda. Among other things, the event highlighted the need to mobilize funding at the local, national and international levels to support the ACE agenda.

The High-level Event mobilized global decisionmakers who committed to climate action in their areas of influence by signing the Burgenland Declaration on Action for Climate Empowerment.



Example: Austrian post authority: Crypto Stamp 3.0, 100.000 cryptostamps á 9 € each, sold out the first day (!) https://crypto.post.at/
Feasibility: Average EU citizen = carbon footprint of 9 tons/year, social costs of carbon estimates > 50 €/ton, new #GoodLife ethical standard asks citizen to invest 450 €/year in local and global climate action/ACE 10 000 citizens (e.g. in a city with climate neutrality goals) -> 4,5 mio € for ACE



Resource Mobilization for ACE Innovations II: NPS Support Structure for Action for Climate Empowerment

A United Citizens Organization for Action for Climate Empowerment, organized as a blockchain based quasi-international organization, for transparent and participatory allocation of mobilized resources and development and administration of intellectual, technological, financial and organizational infrastructure in a "global commons" and "multistakeholder provision of global public goods" conceptual framework



An unprecedented **opportunity for global citizens** (digital climate action
bonds and initial coin offering) and **social impact investors** to invest in securing a
climate safe future
