



FAO Project: Scaling up implementation of Enhanced Lima Work Programme on Gender and its Gender Action Plan in Agriculture

Objective:

- Advance gender-responsive climate action and gender mainstreaming through scaling up the implementation of the Enhanced Lima Work Programme on Gender and its Gender Action Plan in agriculture.

Outcomes:

1. Develop gender-sensitive policies and make decisions based on scientific knowledge and information;
2. Enhance countries' capacities to implement gender-sensitive policies and climate actions in the revised Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) and Koronivia Joint Work on Agriculture;
3. Increase participation and engagement of women in the UNFCCC processes through capacity building, access to information, knowledge products and tools related to the agriculture sector and climate change;
4. Strengthen countries' capacities to enhance synergies in monitoring and reporting for NDCs, KJWA and SDGs using gender-sensitive indicators.
