Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) considered the compilation and synthesis of fifth biennial reports of Parties included in Annex I to the Convention (Annex I Parties)¹ and noted the valuable information therein.

Option 1

2. The SBI took note of the information provided in the compilation and synthesis referred to in paragraph 1 above.

Option 2

2. The SBI noted that the total aggregate greenhouse gas emissions of Annex I Parties increased by 4.4 per cent between 2020 and 2021.²

3. The SBI also noted that, while the total aggregate greenhouse gas emissions of Annex I Parties decreased by 17.3 per cent without land use, land-use change and forestry between 1990 and 2021, the total aggregate greenhouse gas emissions of Parties that do not have an economy in transition decreased by 7.4 per cent without land use, land-use change and forestry in the same period.³

4. The SBI further noted that that total aggregate greenhouse gas emissions of Annex I Parties⁴ are projected to increase by 0.5 per cent between 2020 and 2030 under the ‘with measures’ scenarios reported in fifth biennial reports.⁵

5. The SBI noted that the total amount of climate finance provided by Annex I Parties⁶ to developing countries continued to increase since 2011, but at a slower rate in the two latest bienniums (2017–2018 and 2019–2020) included in the reporting.⁷
