
BR5s and NC8s review-related issues

- During NC8/BR5 reviews (2023/2024), secretariat has continued with the usual practice of collecting information on the review-related issues raised by the ERTs.
- So far, the ERTs have not raised any new major substantive review issue during NC8/BR5 reviews that would need further analysis.
- The ERTs have been addressing similar review issues as in previous BR/NC review cycles, that are already covered in the Review Practice Guidance (RPG).

BR5s and NC8s review-related issues

- RPG continues to serve as a useful and comprehensive tool and guidance to experts in applying consistent approach while reviewing BRs and NCs.
- The only topic of interest that could inform the future review practice under the ETF was approach to assessment of progress towards and achievement of the 2020 target.



Moving forward to BTR1s reviews

- New TERR template for BTR reviews in part related to consideration of progress towards the NDC builds upon the relevant elements on assessment of progress towards the quantified economy-wide emissions reduction target used in the BR reviews and further substantiates it given the diversity of NDCs.
- The secretariat will continue with the established good practice of collecting information on and analyzing the review-related issues raised by the ERTs during the reviews of BTR1s with a view to presenting its analysis for discussion at future ETF LRs meetings, as needed.
