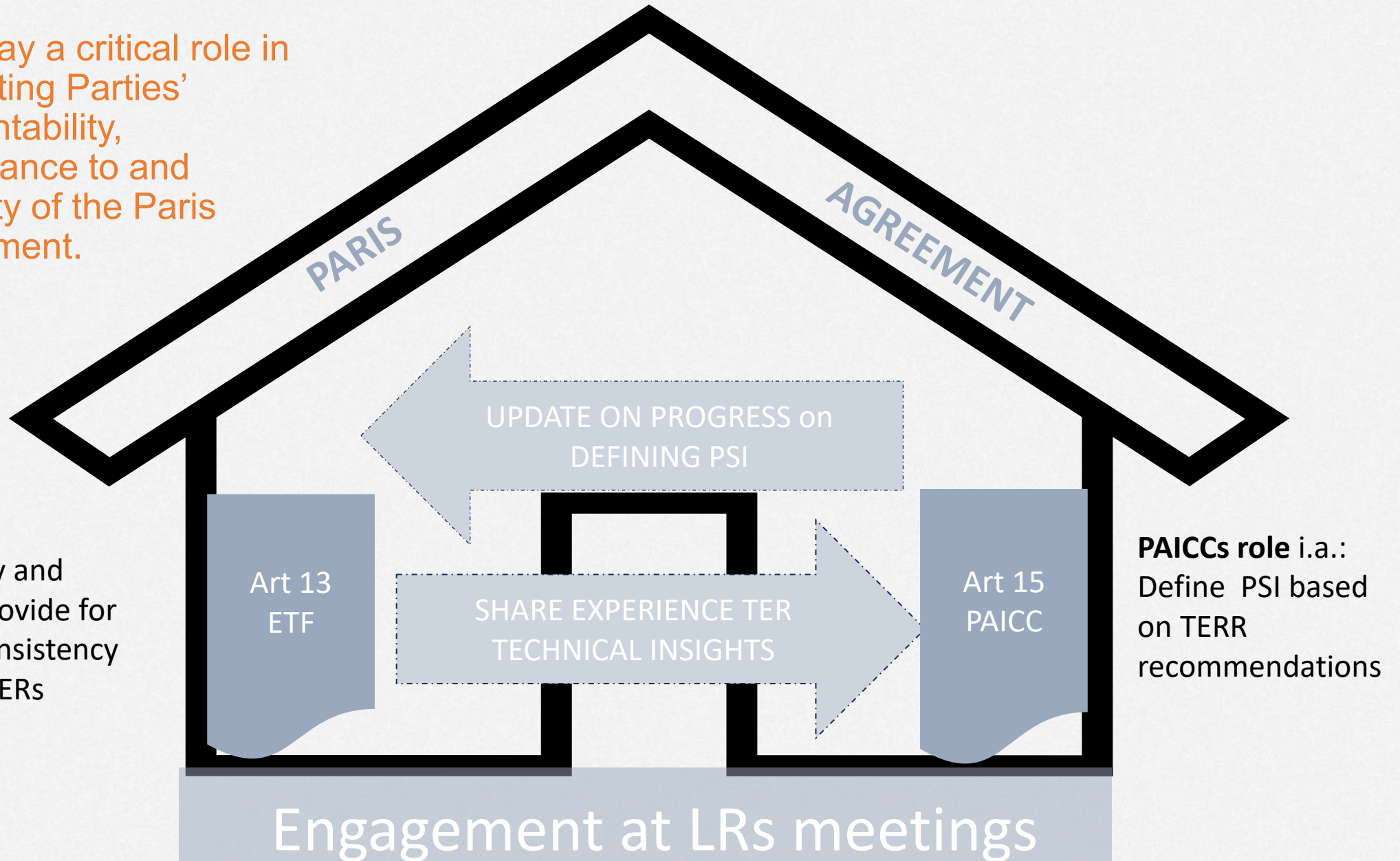

- 1. To PAICC CC: Which approach has been taken by the PAICC and which challenges the PAICC faces in defining SPI on the basis of TERRs?**
- 2. To LRs: Taken your experience as a LR in BTR1 TER what could be possible criteria for PAICC to identify SPI based on TERRs recommendations? How could Parties' diverse national capacities and circumstances be taken into account in defining SPI while maintaining consistency and comparability across Parties?**
- 3. To all panelists: Which mode(s) of engagement between the LRs as a group and the PAICC would most effectively support the identification of SPI by PAICC in 2026 – 2027?**
