The COP30 Presidency invites the participants of the Implementation Forum to a session focused on the COP30 Presidency Roadmap on Enhancing Efforts Towards Halting and Reversing Deforestation and Forest Degradation by 2030.

Halting and reversing deforestation and forest degradation by 2030 is critical to achieving the objectives of the Paris Agreement, conserving biodiversity, and advancing sustainable development. Forests are central to climate stability, ecosystem integrity, water cycles, food security, and the livelihoods of indigenous peoples and local communities. With this in mind, the COP30 Presidency is developing a **Roadmap on Enhancing Efforts Towards Halting and Reversing Deforestation and Forest Degradation by 2030** as an action-oriented contribution to the implementation of paragraphs 33 and 34 of the first Global Stocktake of the Paris Agreement. It aims to identify key drivers of deforestation and forest degradation, as well as practical policies, measures, and means of implementation aimed at addressing these problems. The Roadmap will also identify gaps and obstacles that require enhanced international cooperation.

Climate Week 4 in Baku provides an opportunity to present the **latest updates on the Roadmap to stakeholders and to continue the dialogue to inform its finalization**. The session will be hosted by **COP30 CEO Ana Toni**.
