- Guarantee of Benin's contribution up to 10% of the National Budget

Baseline report on national climate change priorities and targets and relevant capacity development initiatives

- Summary of national CC priorities and objectives expressed through the various national and sector policy and strategy documents;
- Specific actions likely to improve learning in the field of cc and to strengthen institutions involved in learning processes;
- Directory and analysis of relevant national initiatives for the development of cc capacities;
- List of key organizations that can contribute to the implementation of the National Strategy for strengthening human resources, learning and skills development to deal with cc.

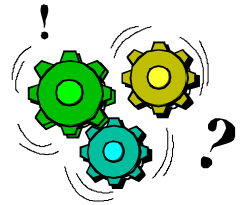
4. Launch workshop

The draft Work Plan of phase 1 of the project

The draft baseline report on national climate change priorities and targets and relevant capacity development initiatives;

The draft Guidance Note and Terms of Reference relating to the development of the National Strategy for strengthening human resources, learning and development of skills to face climate change

5. Strategy development



- Validation of the data and information collection survey
- Validation of the structure of the Strategy - recruitment of a statistician expert to lead the work of data and information collection;
- Recruitment and training of investigating officers;
- Development and validation of the investigation report;
- Establishment of four working groups namely:1 (Primary education), 2 (Secondary education),

5. Strategy development (Cont. & end)

3 (higher education), 4 (administration, private sector and civil society).

Each group is responsible for drafting specific parts of the strategy.

The synthesis, compilation and development of the first version of the Strategy is carried out by the Management Team. The first version of the strategy document was pre-validated and validated by the Steering Committee after the review sessions by the Scientific and Technical Committee.
