David McCauley is an environment, social, governance and climate finance and policy expert with extensive experience at senior levels developing and implementing global, regional, national and local strategies and investments working with both the public and private sectors to improve environmental and natural resources management and climate change mitigation and adaptation. He currently serves as Senior Climate Finance Consultant for the Global Environment Facility (GEF)

supporting enhanced cooperation between GEF and the Green Climate Fund (GCF) under their Long-term Vision for Enhanced Coherence and Complementarity. He is also Co-Chair of the Independent Expert Group for the Nature, People and Climate Program of the Climate Investment Funds. From 2013 to early 2022, he held posts as Senior Vice President at the World Wildlife Fund (WWF), covering partnerships, policy, climate and safeguards for the world's largest environmental organization. Prior to that he spent more than a decade as a senior environment and climate advisor and expert at the Asian Development Bank (ADB) in Manila, finishing as its Head of Climate Programs responsible for oversight of \$3 billion in annual investments. He has advised numerous bilateral and multilateral organizations on these topics, including five years with the US Agency for International Development (USAID) in Indonesia and Washington and has had academic appointments, among others, at Gadjah Mada University in Indonesia and Peredeniya University in Sri Lanka.
