

Emmanuel Dumisani Dlamini is the Principal Secretary in the Ministry of Tourism and Environmental Affairs in the Kingdom of ESwatini. He supervises all the ministry's departments and is the controlling officer of the ministry's fiscal allocation. He holds a Bsc, majoring in Mathematics and Physics, a Post Graduate Diploma in Meteorology and an Msc in Computer Science focusing on climate database. He developed the ESwatini climatological database system and the ESwatini public weather forecast system.

He was the Director of the ESwatini Meteorological Service before becoming the Principal Secretary. He is also the ESwatini National Climate Focal Point and has led to the production of ESwatini's First, Second and Third National Communication.

Mr Dlamini is the lead negotiator of ESwatini under the U.N. Framework Convention of Climate Change (UNFCCC). Over the years, he chaired the African Group of Negotiators under the UNFCCC, chaired the UNFCCC Subsidiary Body for Science and Technological Advice and now he is the UNFCCC Chair of the Subsidiary body of implementation.
