With over 25 years' experience in the fields of sustainability and corporate responsibility, Rob Cameron is Nestlé's Global Head of ESG Engagement. From June 2024, he is the Chair of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) Environment and Energy Commission.

Rob joined Nestlé in January 2020 as Global Head of Public Affairs. He was closely involved in the development of Nestlé's Net Zero Climate Roadmap, its commitments on regenerative agriculture, and the development of the company's Human Rights Roadmap and action plans. He is the Secretary to the Sustainability Committee of Nestlé's Board of Directors.

Rob has represented Nestlé at a wide range of UN meetings including UNFCCC COPs, and the UN Food Systems Summit. He was a member of the World Economic Forum Global Future Council and is an accomplished public speaker.

Prior to joining Nestlé, Rob was Chief Executive of SustainAbility, the internationally respected think tank and consulting firm, now part of the ERM Group where he worked for eight years. From 2008 to 2012, Rob was Chief Executive at Fairtrade International, the global umbrella organization for the Fairtrade movement and was previously owner and Executive Chairman of Flag, an international communications agency specializing in corporate responsibility.
